- The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J&K, Andhra Pradesh & Telangana States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which this LoP is granted for all India quota.
- Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as irregular and action under IMC Act, 1956 & Regulations made thereunder will be initiated.
